The Wriggle Online Store is now open for the purchase of iPad and physical textbooks with free eBooks for 1st Year 2019-2020 in Loreto Abbey Dalkey.

To access the 1st Year online store please visit www.wriggle.ie.
Click '**Order Online**' and input the following code: **56147170**

This is the first year of the new home delivery system which allows Wriggle to deliver each students package straight to your home. This will include their iPad with eBooks preinstalled and the printed textbook bundle. Home delivery will take place in mid-August, providing that the order has been placed by the deadline of 10th June. An instruction leaflet will be placed in each package by Wriggle and it is very important that these instructions are followed carefully.

You will be presented with the following options whilst making your purchase:

- Choice of iPad - 32GB or 128GB (in either Space Grey or Silver).
- The Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) option should only be selected if a compatible iPad is already owned. The minimum requirement is iPad 2017 (5th gen) with 32GB or later, or any model of iPad Pro. Compatible BYOD iPads must be delivered to the school by June 12th. There is an additional €50 charge for BYOD configuration. Please see the attached PDF for more information on BYOD requirement
- Option to purchase a heavy duty iPad case or to choose to purchase your own case separately (BYOC). (Note - the chosen case is a heavy duty case, but this does not have a plastic front screen protector. Some may wish to purchase a more rugged case or a keyboard case, but this is at your discretion.)
- Option to purchase insurance through Gadget Insurance.

The Core Curriculum of printed textbooks and free eBooks has been preselected for all students.

The Optional Curriculum for the 1st Year Online Store relates to the choice of Modern Languages (i.e. French, German and Spanish). All 1st Year students study two Modern Languages. Please ensure that you select the two correct language subjects for your daughter, as indicated and recorded previously with the school.

There will be an option to remove the Irish textbook from your order for students who are exempt from Irish. Please ensure any such exemption has been granted by the Department of Education and that this information has been recorded with the school.

Please find attached the Booklist/eBooklist for 1st Year and information from Wriggle with details of how to proceed with the purchase of iPad and physical textbooks with free eBooks for 1st Year from the Wriggle online store.

On the Booklist/eBooklist, **items listed in red will be purchased from the Wriggle Online Store.**

Other items listed in black, including stationery, hardbacks and copies, art supplies, etc., should be purchased separately from a retail store (i.e. a bookshop, stationery supplies shop, etc.).

Please ensure that purchases are made before the closing date on 10th June.

All incoming students are now part of our whole school 1:1 Mobile Learning Programme with iPad and all purchases, whether a new iPad is purchased or the BYOD option is selected, must be made through the Wriggle Online Store by this deadline.

An increased administration charge of €50 will be applied to all late orders and may result in your daughter's iPad and textbooks not being available in time for the new school year. Additionally, in the event of a late order, eBooks

will not be preloaded onto a student's iPad. In this case, it will be the full responsibility of the student and/or Parent/Guardian to create eBook accounts and to redeem and download all eBooks based on the code printed on textbook covers without assistance from either Wriggle or the school.

As there is now a home delivery system, students will not attend an iPad deployment day on the first day of school as in previous years. However, a more interactive and in-depth iPad induction will take place in school during the first week. Students will then receive their school email address and account details and learn how to use their iPad to enhance their learning. Further details on this will be forwarded in August.
