You need to visit both the Wriggle store (for the iPad) and The Book Haven Online store (for the books).

Step by step

1. Order iPad through Wriggle by June 25th.
2. Order books through The Book Haven link (Books can be purchased elsewhere but the correct bundle and edition will need to be double checked by you. Please make sure it includes a free ebook code, where relevant).
3. iPad will arrive with ebook account login details.
4. Books will arrive separately (free ebook code is inside the book).
5. Use Wriggle ebook account details to sign into all publisher websites/apps (they will be pre-installed on the iPad). A step by step guide to signing into all publisher websites is attached.
6. Use ebook codes (on the inside of the books) to activate ebooks through the publisher websites/apps before your daughter starts school in August.

Booklist FAQ's

Q: The book I want to order is out of stock on The Book Haven website. Can I buy from somewhere else?

Yes absolutely, but please be very careful when searching for the exact title, edition, author, set and publisher that has been listed on our designated Book Haven store. Please make sure it includes a free ebook, where relevant.

Q: My older daughter has some of the books from the booklist and is no longer using them. Can my younger daughter use them?

Technically yes, if they are the exact same edition. However, please bear in mind that ebook codes can only be redeemed once. It is likely that your older daughter has already redeemed the code and your younger daughter would not be able to use the ebook. You can purchase ebook codes individually from the publisher websites if you wish for a slightly lower price than purchasing a new textbook with free ebook code. It's important to be aware that textbook publishers produce a new edition of textbooks every 3-4 years and individual subject departments may change their textbook selection every few years also, meaning there are currently few opportunities to use second-hand books.
