SION HILL

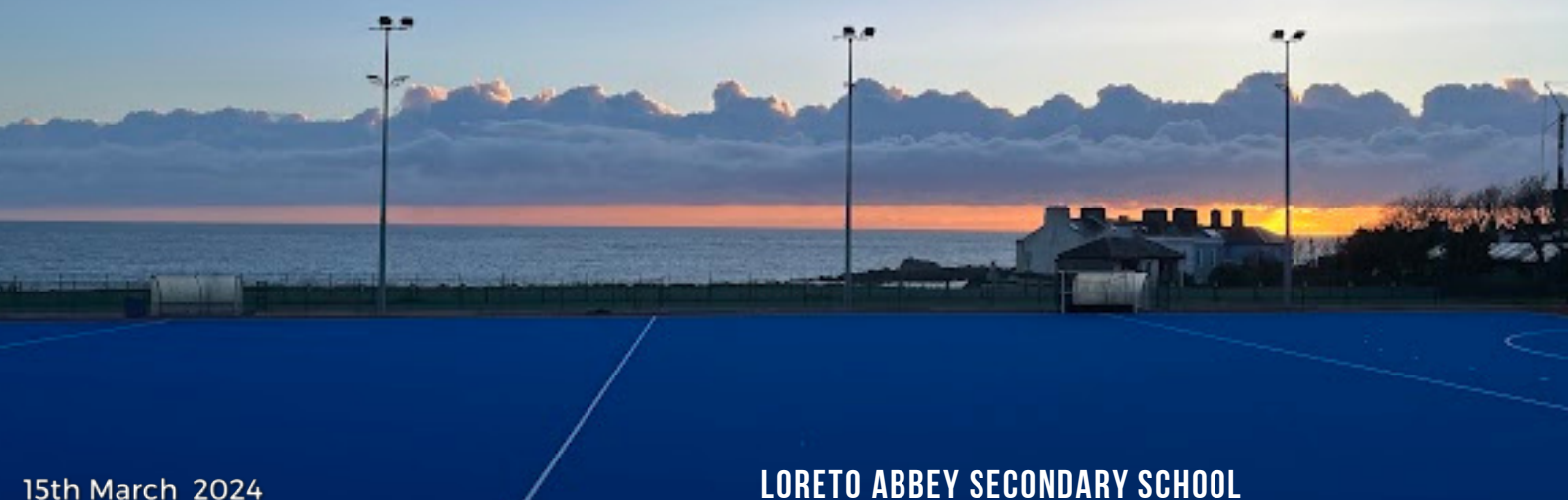
